### 1 Invitation

We invite you to submit a paper in the area of Cybersecurity Education to the Technical Session that we are organizing at SAM'15, the 14th International Conference on Security and Management. SAM'15 is part of WORLDCOMP'15: The 2015 World Congress in Computer Science, Computer Engineering and Applied Computing. WORLDCOMP'15 will be held in Las Vegas, Nevada, USA during the period July 27-30, 2015. ### 2 Description of Technical Session

As the importance of cybersecurity in our society grows, it is clear that we are not producing nearly enough people skilled in this area. Cybersecurity education is the key to producing people more skilled at cyber defense. This session will focus on ways to enhance cybersecurity education for researchers, graduate students, undergraduate students, high school students, middle school students, members of the workforce and the general public. This session will provide information about curriculum, tools, environments and the use of cyber defense competitions to motivate students at both the collegiate and high school levels. This session will also focus on research problems that come from efforts to support cybersecurity education. We welcome submissions on all facets of cybersecurity education. This technical session will bring international focus to the importance of cybersecurity education since the estimated 2,000 participants at WORLDCOMP15 are able to attend any of the sessions that interest them.

### 3 Types of Papers

We are interested in contributions of the following types:

- (RRP) Regular Research Papers. These are 7-page papers that will appear in the proceedings. These

papers will be presented in a 20-minute formal presentation slot.

- (RRR) Regular Research Reports. These are 7-page papers that will appear in the proceedings. The presentations for these papers will be in informal settings during Discussion Sessions. Typically, those authors with language difficulties prefer this mode of presentation.
- (SRP) Short Research Papers. These are 4-page papers that will appear in the proceedings. The presentations for these papers will be in informal settings during discussion sessions.
- (PST) Posters. These are 2-page papers that will appear in the proceedings. The presentations for these papers will be in informal settings during discussion sessions.

- Thursday, April 16, 2015. Draft papers due.
- Thursday, April 30, 2015. Acceptance of papers announced by this date. The sooner you can submit your paper, the sooner you can get feedback.
- Saturday, May 16, 2015. Camera ready papers uploaded and registration completed.
